PK71™ consists of three nesting tables that can be stored under each other. With these tables and their progressive 3-dimensional shape, Poul Kjærholm was showing the square in all 3 dimensions in his work for the first time. They can be seen as a precursor to his larger and more complex tables.

With their toy-like appearance, the small, abstract tables are very dynamic and they invite you to move them around. Poul Kjærholm often stacked the bare frames as sculptural symbols to illustrate the elementary properties of his other works. The importance of PK71 is shown by the fact the tables are displayed in the permanent collection at the Museum of Modern Art in New York.

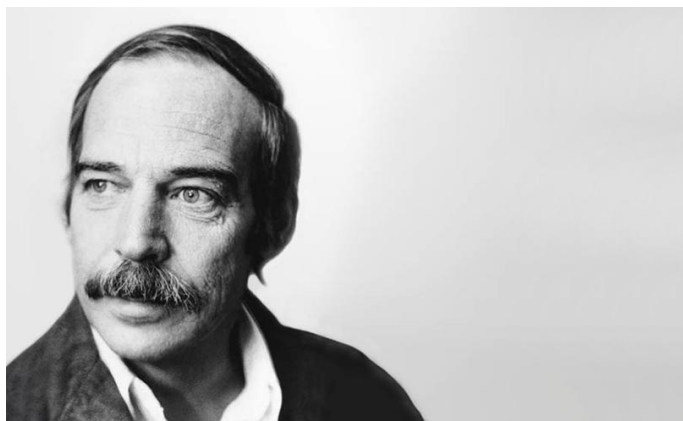


PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

POUL KJÆRHOLM 1929-1980

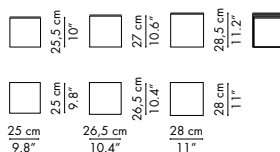
Poul Kjærholm was a trained cabinet maker and continued his studies at the Danish School of Arts and Crafts in Copenhagen. He had a particular interest in different construction materials, especially steel, which he considered a natural material with the same artistic fineness as other natural materials.

Poul Kjærholm was first employed at Fritz Hansen for about a year, where he designed a number of noteworthy chair prototypes. In 1955, Poul Kjærholm initiated his collaboration with manufacturer Ejvind Kold Christensen, which lasted until Kjærholm's death in 1980. In 1982, Fritz Hansen took over the manufacture and sales of "The Kjærholm Collection", which was developed over the period 1951 to 1967.

MATERIALS

Table top:

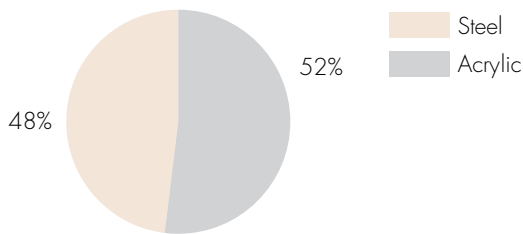
The table tops are made from a coloured acrylic thermo plastic which can be melted for re-use.

Base:

The bases are made of satin brushed stainless steel and can be recycled.

Materials in %

The below figures illustrate the weight allocation between the different materials used. Items with a weight <1% of the total product weight are not included in the figures below.



PACKAGING MATERIAL

The tables are shipped in a cardboard box. Inside the box the tables are covered with a plastic bag and protected by PE foam. All packaging material can be recycled.

REPAIR, DISPOSAL AND REUSE

In case of repair and disposal the tables can be disassembled into two parts (table tops and bases) for recycling. Check local regulations for recycling in your area and whether there is potential for reuse.



MANUFACTURING PROCESSES

Metals

Production scrap is collected for recycling.
