DESCRIPTION

With a broken twill structure, the Ply Rug has an eclectic yet understated appearance through its graphic pattern. Please note that the Ply Rug 400 x 400 cm / I3.I x I3.I" and 360 x 270 cm / II.8 x 8.9" are not available in Burnt Orange.

PRODUCTION PROCESS

Wool is dye colored and rugs are woven by hand.

MATERIAL

100% New Zealand wool

SPARE PARTS

Rug pads to place under the Ply Rugs are purchased separately. This prevents the rugs from gliding and protects the rug.

CLEANING AND CARE

For regular cleaning, vacuum the rugs. Clean stains instantly with sparkling water. The rugs should be turned every 6 months for maintenance purposes.
